Thought for the Day

Tuesday is St Luke's Day. He wrote the most popular and loved of the Gospels. Luke is seen to be very much "on the side of the people" - those who are underprivileged in the society in which he lived, especially women. Luke's sympathy and empathy has won him the hearts of millions of Christians down the centuries. The Gospel has a special interest in the Gentiles. Its message is of salvation for everyone in the world. The Gospel tells of the Birth of Jesus in Bethlehem, with the Holy Family visited by shepherds. It relates the parables of the Prodigal Son, the Rich Man and Lazarus, and the Good Samaritan. Luke's Gospel has the wonderful Easter story of the appearance of the Risen Jesus on the road to Emmaus. All these stories are only in Luke's Gospel. The theme of joy runs through the whole Gospel, from the singing of the angels at Jesus' birth to the end of the story where the disciples return to Jerusalem "with great joy" after the ascension of Jesus on the Mount of Olives. In a world where people long for unity, stability and joy, we need to hear Luke more than ever.
