Electoral Roll: The Electoral Roll for The Abbey, Castleton and St Paul's is being revised in advance of the APCM on Sunday 11 May 2025 (4.00 pm, Digby Memorial Church Hall). To be eligible to vote at the APCM, you must be on the roll but all are welcome to attend. The Electoral Roll has to be fully revised every 6th year (this year), which means deleting the previous version—everybody is removed! To be on the new Roll, and eligible to vote at the APCM, you will need to re-apply using the yellow forms at the back of your church. All forms must be returned by Saturday 26 April 2025 if you wish to vote at the APCM. After this date, no additions can be made until after the APCM.
